EXPLOSIVE MINE chased the early leaders two wide, angled out three wide at the top of the stretch to place a bid, wore down his foes in deep stretch and drew clear. MARQUEE AVENUE dueled from the outside early three wide, fought hard in the stretch but was unable to resist the winner and gave way grudgingly. HOLLYWOOD SHOWBIZ dueled from along the inside, saved ground throughout, battled into deep stretch then yielded in the final yards. QUICKLY was unhurried early saving ground, angled out five wide into the stretch and showed some effort late. MASTER RALEIGH was forwardly placed four wide then went evenly late. RIG'S RUNNER raced mid pack saving ground and lacked a response. AWESOME AMIGO was off slow early, went three wide and lacked a rally. FAST A NUFF hopped at the start to get away poorly and was not a factor. RUFFY TRICK raced four wide then retreated.
