Footnotes

SILVER TOHATCHI away a bit slowly, was settled off the inside, gradually closed the gap on the backstretch, circled rivals five wide on the turn, angled in some entering the lane, battled and edged ahead the final sixteenth. PUTTHEHAMMERDOWN stalked from between horses, moved up four wide on the backstretch to share the lane, had a slight advantage two wide on the second turn, fought gamely through the stretch but did not have enough in the waning yards. SHOOTER'S TOUCH raced in contention from outside, also came up to share the lead outside PUTTHEHAMMERDOWN on the backstretch, also battled gamely when set down for the drive, was outfinished but easily best of the rest. PERSHING progressed from inside, angled out midway on the backstretch, still threatened while taking the second turn four then five wide but wore down in the lane. STORMIN STORY prominent from the beginning, contested the pace two wide on the backstretch, began to back up a bit nearing the second turn, was steadied into that bend when his path was taken, altered out three wide then also did not have enough left for the stretch run. REAL COOL JAZZ was soon far back, commenced his bid from inside on the second turn, swung out leaving that bend, drifted out to the middle of the track entering the stretch and passed tired ones. HOPE FOR PEACE went for the lead three wide on the backstretch, failed to keep up just off the inside on the second turn, swung out to path six into the lane and steadily gave way. BOURBON CAT soon had the lead, showed the way just off or along the rail, was challenged on the backstretch and faded from inside on the second turn. FAIR MARKET VALUE was a contender from outside for seven furlongs then began to tire.
