DOS AND DON'TS was forwardly placed five wide, sustained a bid three wide at the quarter pole, moved up to duel with SKY JEDI in the final strides then inched away at the wire. SKY JEDI chased the early leaders four wide, vied into the stretch to duel to the wire battling with DOS AND DON'TS but was outfinished in the final strides. ACCOLADES N PRAISE was off slow early, rallied four wide, was gaining in the stretch and was up in time for the show. NOW AND ZEN was unhurried early racing six wide and lacked a closing response. MAJOR BILLY was outrun early, went three wide and lacked a gain late. CONCORDES SAINT raced mid pack saving ground then faded. HOYA was void of early speed saving ground and lacked a bid. ALL MAXED OUT set the early pace, was used up after a half and stopped.
