MR. PURSUIT set a pressured pace early, saved ground throughout, kicked clear nearing the eighth pole and was best late. CANTALLBECHIEFS pressed the early pace from the outside, failed to match strides with the winner and went evenly late. PERSHING chased the early leaders racing off the rail, angled out nearing the quarter pole, lacked a gain late but held the show. OVERLAND was unhurried early racing well off the rail, placed a mild bid nearing the quarter pole but failed to rally in the stretch. THE BIG ONE was allowed to settle early racing three wide and failed to sustain a bid. OLIVER TWISTED was forwardly placed early three wide then gave way. CONTINUUM dropped back early and placed a mild effort four wide. SWORDSMITH retreated steadily. TWIN TURBO failed to threaten. HOLDING SLEW showed little saving ground and was not a factor.
