MR. TRIESTE shared the early lead from outside in hand, took the second turn three wide, drew off with little asking in the lane and proved much the best ridden out. BAYOU THE MOON disputed the pace between rivals from the beginning, moved to the rail in the upper stretch, was no match for the winner but clearly second best. WARN ME AGAIN battled for the early lead from inside but wore down the last three-sixteenths. QUESTION (ARG) in contention early toward the outside, lost ground five wide on the second turn, lacked a stretch bid and lugged in late. PLEASANT BEND raced with QUESTION (ARG) from just inside most of the way, had no rally and was crowded in the late. FIN ENTERTAINMENT far back early, saved ground and passed tired ones in the stretch. EL CURIOSO settled outside, made his bid on the second turn but flattened out for the drive. CALIBAN stayed well off the rail most of the way and showed little. RAYO DE PLATA not far off the inside, was never close. CLIFF NOTES boxed in behind the pace on the backstretch, gave way inside on the second turn.
