MISSIX broke sharply and pressed the pace while racing three wide, gained command at the at the five-sixteenths and increased her margin under intermittent urging. LADY IN KAPOWSIN stalked the pace off the rail, was no match for the winner but finished willingly for the place. WESTERN KAPER dropped back shortly after the start, was allowed to settle in stride, swung six wide for the drive and showed good late interest. SURE RUNAWAY was unhurried early off the rail and improved his position late. WHITE STAR DELIGHT settled outside a rival, was fanned five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. LUCERNA vied for the lead while racing two wide and weakened in the final furlong. SOUTHERN POWER dueled for the lead along the inside, swung out four wide into the stretch and stopped in the late stages. GALLANT VENTURE was always outrun in a ground-saving trip.
