Footnotes

TWEED SUIT rated between horses early, progressed just off the rail on the bend, angled out three wide nearing the eighth pole and caught SPORT nearing the wire. SPORT soon gained the lead, set the pace from paths two or three, lengthened command in the stretch, did not have enough left the last sixteenth but was clearly best of the rest. DR. DEPUTY pressed the early speed between rivals, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. SLEW STUFF pressed SPORT early from just outside, took the turn three wide, altered out some to stay clear of TWEED SUIT in the upper stretch and gradually wore down. BREW'S FLAMIN SLEW crowded at the start, was well placed early along the rail but gave way leaving the turn. SILK CREEK bobbed at the start, leaned in, bumped OJO MUERTO, advanced outside, lost ground six wide into the lane and lacked a stretch bid. WINDS OF FORTUNE broke outward, was a brief contender, moved off the rail nearing the turn then steadily faded. SNEAKERS 'N' JEANS failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. REGULATOR dwelt at the start then bore in on leaving the gate and showed little in a wide trip. OJO MUERTO bumped at the start, stayed well off the rail and was never a factor. REAL COOL JAZZ broke inward, bobbed and never reached contention.
