IFOUNDMY MOJO rated off the early speed, picked up his pace three wide on the turn, fanned out further for a clear path entering the stretch, gained the advantage just inside the final furlong, responded to mostly hand urging and steadily opened up. GENTSFINISHFIRST unruly in the gate, was in hand while being forced in early, altered outside GET BACK MAN near the half mile marker, went for the lead three wide on the turn, had the advantage midstretch, was no match for IFOUNDMY MOJO the final sixteenth, all out between rivals and lasted for the place. REMUS settled outside, took the turn four wide, bid in the stretch, finished evenly but caught INTHENICKOFTIME for third. INTHENICKOFTIME a step slow at the break, moved up from inside to vie for the lead into the bend, battled gamely for second inside the last furlong, did not have enough left nearing the wire but was easily best of the rest. GET BACK MAN steadily angled in as he set a pressured pace in the early going, was challenged from both side into the turn and wore down two wide the last quarter mile. HEAR NO ANGEL failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. DEVOUR broke awkwardly, showed no speed, was just off the rail on the turn, floated out entering the stretch and little to offer. THE FIVE FURLONG FRACTION WAS UNAVAILABLE.
