Footnotes

MR. TRIESTE broke awkwardly, was kept close between rivals, made his move four wide into the second turn, rallied in the lane, brushed with SKIP AND GO in the deep stretch, got up near the wire and established a new track record. SKIP AND GO pressed the early speed from outside, took over the lead on the second turn and moved in some, drifted out under a left whip inside the final furlong, brushed MR. TRIESTE and was narrowly outfinished in a game effort. LONG RANGE was kept close, went for the lead three wide on the second turn, moved inside SKIP AND GO in the upper stretch and slowly wore down. DESERT DARBY was well placed inside through the early going but wore down leaving the second turn. SWIFT FOR SURE set the early pace off the rail, was overtaken into the second turn, angled out five wide near the quarter pole and gradually weakened. WILLIONAIRE an early contender inside, was swung out six wide for room on the second turn but had no late bid. FACE THE BAND was taken outside once on the backstretch and failed to menace. LATENITE TRICK was an early factor between rivals but came up empty into the second turn.
