STAR SMASHER stalked the early leader, bid three wide and took over into the lane, weakened slightly in the deep stretch but lasted under strong handling. NINETY NINE JACK was out of it early, circled the field seven wide into the stretch, got up for the place fifty yards out and was closing in on the winner. ROYAL DE HOPE tracked the pace comfortably, bid four wide on the turn to loom a threat but raced evenly in the stretch and lost second nearing the wire. HOW BOUT NOW bid five wide entering the stretch but could make up no late ground. QUICKKEY was sent to the lead from the two path on what appeared to be a comfortable pace but weakened through the stretch. WHY TWO KAY OKAY made a mild middle move six wide but flattened out in the drive. TRIXIE'S CHOKEM attempted a rally from five wide on the turn but did not have enough kick. CO TWINING NINER chased the early leader two wide between foes but tired through the drive. FAN JET FALCON was no threat. PRAIRIE FIRE chased the pace from inside but was on empty in the stretch. JOSE CAN YOU SEE was jostled hard between foes going to the main track and proved no factor afterwards. GRAY RYDER was pinched back early and backed up inside. The stewards conducted an inquiry into JOSE CAN YOU SEE being jostled hard onto the main track and declared no change to the order of finish.
