Footnotes

HUSH'S STORM broke inward, bumping HUSH'S STORM, was kept close between horses, three then four wide taking the turn, moved clear upper stretch, steadily opened up under a drive, was kept to task until the final seventy yards then finished in hand. SPOILYNDEEKID contested the pace between horses, had a narrow advantage just off the rail entering the lane, crowded briefly by RUN LIKE AN OUTLAW upper stretch, drifted out to bump the latter inside the furlong marker, fought to keep second to the wire and narrowly prevailed. RUN LIKE AN OUTLAW vied for the lead just outside SPOILYNDEEKID, lugged in some upper stretch, was corrected, bumped and forced out a bit after entering the last eighth, battled gamely to the wire for second but missed. COOPER CANYON duelled for the lead from inside, could not keep up leaving the turn, altered out five wide at the head of the lane, lacked a serious bid but was closing the gap on the second flight. WHATA TERAS bumped at the break, quickly recovered to dispute the pace between horses, was two wide on the bend, could not keep up leaving the turn, moved to the rail upper stretch and finished evenly. AWESOME CITY chased from outside, lost considerable ground widest through the turn then improved position in the stretch without threatening. HAY MAN MARK an early factor toward the outside, began to tire five wide on the turn. JOHAN A soon trailed, was just off the rail on the turn, fanned out some entering the lane, altered out for a clear path upper stretch and passed some tired ones. DOMS WONDER prominent between horses, faded just off the inside on the turn. SLEW'S ROYAL TOWER was a contender

between rivals on the backstretch, could not keep up four wide on the turn, swung out further for the drive but had little left. PIE TOWN N M moved to the inside early on, saved ground through the bend, angled out for a clear path upper stretch but had no late bid.
