Footnotes

NUGGETS PLEASE was off slow early to be well back early, went four wide into the turn, swung out nine wide at the top of the stretch and closed with a rush to surge clear. OUR CHOICE was outrun early racing off the rail, drifted out eight wide near the three sixteenths, closed well but didn't have enough late. MOSTLY DUST broke sharply to set the early pace drawing clear, was challenged in the stretch and came up empty in the drive. ATTITUDE E RACER forced the early pace three wide then tired and weakened. HUNTING DIXIE was unhurried early, went seven wide near the three sixteenth and lacked a gain late. DESERT HENNESSY was forwardly placed early five wide then tired and gave way. CHUCHULUCO was close in the early going along the rail then faded in the stretch. SMASH DANCER was never far back early between foes then retreated steadily. LESTERS SECRET was allowed to settle early three wide, lacked a late response and yielded.
