BROTHER LOUIE advanced between horses, angled in on the turn, got through in close quarters along the rail at the top of the stretch then gradually opened up under steady urging. FAST A NUFF forwardly placed from outside, closed the gap though five wide on the turn, could not keep up entering the lane but took over second inside the final sixteenth. COWBOY HENNESSY a step slow at the break, rushed up from inside to gain a narrow advantage, was just off the inside through the bend, could not stay with BROTHER LOUIE in the stretch and slowly yielded the last eighth. VINCENT soon moved inside, was caught in tight quarters against the rail on the turn, checked nearing the quarter pole, altered out to path six upper stretch and improved position without threatening. COSMIC CHI also step slow at the break, was hustled up to vie for the lead between horses, three wide through the stretch and also wore down for the drive. THATSNOLIE was soon well back, made up ground four wide on the bend, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch run and passed a couple tired ones. DUNN SLINGER was an early contender between horses, four wide through the bend then flattened out in the lane. ALONE FEDERALI a step slow, as well, at the start, soon moved up between horses, was just off the rail into the turn, brushed with VINCENT several times, began to back up leaving the bend, angled out to path five upper stretch and continued to fade.
