JAM'N JACKSON kept close toward the outside, was three wide on the turn, floated out to path five entering the stretch, lugged in some under right-handed pressure after entering the final furlong and edged ahead of CITY SAGE nearing the wire. CITY SAGE broke alertly and was hustled clear, steadily angled in, had the rail on the turn, drifted out to path three for the stretch run, lengthened his lead under urging but began to wear down the last sixteenth. DUCKY DRAKE settled just off the inside, was two wide through the bend, blocked entering the lane, began to gradually alter out upper stretch, gained a clear path six wide approaching the final sixteenth and closed strongly. GRAND SLAM ANDRE in midpack between rivals on the backstretch, was also just off the inside on the turn, fanned four wide into the lane, gradually angled in upper stretch to be just off the inside with a furlong left, continued to close the gap but came up short. KINETICAT YANKEE also chased from midpack while outside on the backstretch, was widest through the bend and forced out some approaching the last sixteenth as he rallied belatedly. STEPHENGOTHISSTAR settled inside, picked up his pace along the rail leaving the turn, was checked behind PACK YOUR BAGS after entering the last eighth, altered out three wide then continued to make up ground. PACK YOUR BAGS rated from between rivals early, had the rail on the turn, floated out some into the lane, had a striking position as he altered in midstretch to stay clear of GRAND SLAM ANDRE but gradually yielded instead. COWBOY'S PRAYER prominent early, bid just outside the leader through the bend, could not stay with CITY SAGE upper stretch and flattened out four wide the last furlong.
