BENCH BEAUTY settled behind early pacesetters then angled out to three wide at top of stretch and dug in down the lane for the victory. SMOKEM BULL travelled four wide throughout and held on for place. WINNIE CAPPELLA rushed from outset to share command as the outer most of five down the backstretch then entered the stretch three wide and failed to match strides with top pair in late going. STORMIN CREEK lacked a needed rally after angling out near the quarter pole to advance. GIFT CARD lost ground to front runners by drifting out at top of stretch as the widest of all foes. CEE'S JOY passed tiring foes after trailing the field early. TIGER TONE saved ground and had no offering to give in homestretch. SILENT RIDE showed eagerness early and pressed the pace from between rivals for the opening half before fading rapidly in the late going.
