SHAZBOT was allowed to settle early saving ground, angled out off the inside to place a bid at the top of the stretch, was urged steadily through the stretch and edged clear nearing the wire. SUPER CHAMP chased the early leader along the inside, rallied angling out three wide and finished willingly to gain the place. MR. SCARFACE raced mid pack four wide, vied in the stretch and was up in time for the show. ELEGANT ATTITUDE set the early pace drawing clear, held to mid stretch, was challenged and failed to last. SARATOGA POP A TOP was within striking distance early racing four wide, drifted out six wide in the stretch and lacked a gain. ROYAL REVENGE was forwardly placed early three wide between foes, placed a brief bid then gave way. LE GRANDE'S SPIRIT showed little in a dull effort. MISCHEVIOUS KING dropped back racing well off the inside, lost contact with the field, began to gain some ground into the stretch and passed a tiring foe. KID CRAWFORD was outrun and lacked a late effort. RED TAPPER bolted to the inside shortly after the break and unseated his rider. There was a Stewards Inquiry into the start and after reviewing the films it was determined that RED TAPPER had a fair start so no changes were made.
