Footnotes

MATTO MONDO (CHI) rated on the front end between horses, was roused two wide leaving the turn, shook free nearing the sixteenth marker and held off WESTERN PINE under steady handling. WESTERN PINE stumbled at the break, quickly recovered, went for the lead four wide on the bend, angled in some upper stretch, closed well, missed but was clearly second best. FIVE STAR DAVID soon contested the pace from inside, fought gamely to inside the last eighth then began to wear down and narrowly held third. TIZ TRUE showed first, contested the pace from outside, did not keep up three wide leaving the turn, angled outside WESTERN PINE upper stretch and was closing in on FIVE STAR DAVID for the show late. VICTOR WACO bumped at the start, was without early speed, just off the rail on the turn, fanned four wide into the lane, drifted out midstretch, was altered back in with a sixteenth to go and was making up ground after that. BAIL OUT THE CAT saved ground on the turn, came off the rail some for a clear path and made up minor ground the final eighth. RIVER ECHO hesitated then broke in the air, advanced outside to gain a striking position five wide on the turn but could not sustain his bid in the lane. HIDDEN RECIPE broke inward, bumping VICTOR WACO, soon trailed, stayed well off the inside taking the bend and closed the gap some deep stretch without threatening. PRETEND AND EXTEND void of speed from inside, swung out some entering the lane, gradually angled in and lacked a significant response.
