Footnotes

PLINX BLINX in the second flight between horses, was blocked on the bend, swung four wide into the lane, took over midstretch then was driven clear. NEW VOGUE prominent from outside, advanced three wide on the turn, gained second inside the final furlong but was no match for PLINX BLINX. MY OLE GIRLFRIEND stumbled at the start, quickly recovered to vie for the lead between rivals, moved clear and stayed just off the inside through the turn, was challenged from outside upper stretch and slowly yielded the last eighth. LADY DEBRA JANE drifted out some shortly after the break, was corrected, chased from outside, was widest through the bend and gradually improved position in the stretch without threatening. MAG without early speed, was four wide on the turn, angled inside looking for room entering the lane, moved out some for a clear path upper stretch and passed tired ones. LAVISPA also stumbled at the break and quickly recovered, dueled for the lead, could not keep up along the rail through the bend and continued to flatten for the drive. SILVER BULLET BABE in midpack from inside, angled out through the turn, came three wide into the stretch and gave way. JOHANNA'S GRAND broke somewhat slowly and outward, was checked, trailed, came off the inside for the stretch run and proved empty.
