PAID IN FULL kept close, went for the lead three wide leaving the turn, moved clear as he began to lug in upper stretch, lengthened command with nearing the sixteenth marker and narrowly held off SEASAR M D. The latter, prominent from the beginning, had the rail on the turn, was steadied when his path narrowed nearing the eighth pole, altered out, drifted out further, was corrected deep stretch, closed well but too late. WYATT boxed in on the backstretch, was just off the rail on the turn, swung out to path four for room into the lane, closed well and gained third. BETTERTHANBOB gradually retreated from inside, swung out three wide entering the stretch and also rallied belatedly between rivals. CITY CARTEL altered his path several times trying to stay clear on the backstretch, lost ground four to six wide taking the bend and also found best stride too late. FLAGS JOURNEY unruly behind the gate, stumbled inward at the start, bumping PULPITS ATTITUDE, failed to keep up three wide on the turn, fanned out to path five into the lane and steadily made up ground. PULPITS ATTITUDE bumped solidly and steadied at the break, was taken outside early on, widest taking the turn and closed the gap belatedly, as well, the final furlong. HE'S A WHIZ showed first, was soon just off the inside, widened his lead taking the turn but began to tire two wide at the top of the lane.
