Footnotes

CALI BABY settled early, circled rivals six wide when urged on the turn, was under a steady drive in the lane, took over midstretch and shook free in the waning yards. HAPPY ME in contention from inside, angled out to progress on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, dueled for the lead, did not have enough left the final sixteenth but proved clearly best of the rest. GLORY BE MINE contested the pace between horses from the beginning, gained the rail on the turn, began to back up inside the furlong marker, fought for third nearing the wire and gained it. ASKMETODANCE in the second flight between rivals, closed the gap three wide on the turn, battled for the lead with a furlong to go, could not stay with the top pair late, battled for third but was outfinished. AMBERS PRIDE was a contender on the backstretch, failed to keep up three wide on the turn, fanned out to path five for the stretch run, steadily advanced and was closing in for the show approaching the wire. POCKETFULLACHIME vied for the lead from outside, was two wide through the bend and also did not have enough left deep stretch. TERAS BABY void of early speed, saved ground through the turn, gained a striking position along the rail upper stretch but leveled off instead. MYLILMEMO also without early foot, lost ground making her bid as she took the turn five and six wide, altered outside CALI BABY upper stretch and hung inside the last eighth. WILDWOOD BAND was soon well back, stayed wide on the bed, came into the lane from the middle of the track and passed some tired ones. ELVIRA WHO rated just off the inside, bid two wide entering the stretch, became a contender soon after but flattened out the last sixteenth. DIAMONDS N BLING was sent to dispute the pace just off the rail, failed to keep up on the bend, was three wide into the stretch and continued to give way. I AM LESTERS GAL bobbed at the start, moved up quickly from outside, was four wide on the turn but floated out as she gave way leaving the bend.
