Footnotes

BANDZINI stalked between horses, bid three wide on the bend, dueled in the stretch, was bumped nearing the sixteenth marker and edged ahead late. DOODAT contested the pace two wide, gained the rail leaving the turn, drifted out nearing the sixteenth marker, bumping BANDZINI, was corrected and proved easily second best. JONES vied for the lead three wide for a half mile, angled in some leaving the turn and could only narrowly hold third. MURDEROUS hesitated at the break, waited for room inside, angled four wide for the stretch run and lacked the needed bid. BIG JOHN BEAN broke in the air, was blocked early and looking for room, checked entering the turn, altered out, was three wide into the lane and steadily improved position. JACKPOT WHO bobbled at the start, was forwardly placed behind the early speed, just off the rail for the drive and lacked a significant response. SLICKUNO a brief factor toward the outside, was five wide into the stretch and did not have enough left. O K'S BLUFF displayed early speed inside but flattened out the last quarter mile. POPZ pressed from outside, angled in to path four leaving the turn, altered out for room upper stretch and steadily gave way. WILDINTHEWILDWEST dwelt at the start and failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. SOUTHERN BRO void of speed, was just off the inside taking the bend, swung to the outside for the stretch run and had little to offer. RICHLAND B MILLER also hesitated at the break, was taken outside, altered in entering the bend and was empty for the drive.
