Footnotes

TRICKY LADD, urged along from inside, altered out some for room to progress on the turn, came five wide into the lane, closed under a steady drive, took the advantage nearing the sixteenth marker and was drawing away in the waning yards. FLOMOT, without early foot just off the inside, picked up his pace on the turn, swung six wide for the stretch run, angled in some inside the last sixteenth and swept past the early front runners nearing the wire. UNCLE JACK G moved up from outside, was five wide early in the turn, angled in some as he battled for the lead leaving the bend, had a brief advantage inside the furlong marker, was no match for the top pair but held on for third. RADCLIFFE MAN fought for the lead inside from the beginning, did not relent after

UNCLE JACK G took the lead deep stretch but missed for the show. GULCHRUNSSWEET disputed the pace between rivals, two wide through the turn, in tight quarters briefly at the head of the lane and also did not have enough left in the waning yards. TOP DANCER vied for the lead between horses on the backstretch, was three wide taking the bend, tried hard through the lane but also came up a bit short. OH THREE JACK was soon well back, had the inside on the turn, came off the rail some for the stretch run and gradually angled out as he improved position the last eighth. BELLS N CHIMES, an early factor between horses, closed the gap just off the inside on the turn, altered out some upper stretch, was steadied briefly behind traffic and lacked the needed late bid. DIXIE BANDJO, midpack between rivals on the backstretch, was three wide on the turn, swung outside leaving the bend, came into the lane from the middle of the track and failed to have a significant response. PACHE OF GOLD, slow and awkward at the break, lost position three wide on the bend, floated out to the middle of the track for the stretch run and proved empty. FLY LESTER FLY dueled for the early lead from outside, began to fade four wide leaving the bend, fanned out further entering the lane and gave way. Due to a photo finish malfunction, the beaten lengths were approximated by the Equibase chart caller.
