Footnotes

STASH THE TRASH broke inward, was sent to the lead, showed the way just off the inside, lengthened his lead on the bend, was roused leaving the turn, under urging until the final sixteenth and held sway. MYSTICALUNDERTONES a step slow at the break, was rated from inside, under a steady drive the last quarter mile, closed well but was too late. ENJOY MY WIN was prominent just outside STASH THE TRASH on the backstretch, failed to keep up from path two on the turn, started to gradually drift out nearing the eighth pole, was corrected inside the final sixteenth but did not have enough left. THREEGOODKIDS in midpack early, angled in some with a half mile left, took the bend three and four wide then lacked a significant stretch response. LEADSHANK also broke inward, soon trailed, was just off the inside entering the bend, swung out five wide for the stretch run and passed some tired ones. CALL IT A NIGHT gradually backed up from outside, was also in paths three or four through the turn and proved empty for the drive. RUN LIKE HENNESSY pressed the early speed from outside, took the bend from path three then flattened out between rivals in the lane.
