GLOVEDON'TFITAQUIT was allowed to settle early racing five wide, placed a bid to duel briefly then surged clear and widened. FLAME BROILED was off slow early, sustained a steady effort, went five wide at the three sixteenth pole, finished willingly but was no match for the winner. ALI BABA dueled four wide from between rivals then weakened in the lane. DISTINCT LUCK was outrun early, swung out seven wide into the stretch and sustained a mild effort. OVER THE RIVER dueled six wide then tired and faded. MERCY STAR dueled from between rivals then gave way. BRICK MAKER dueled from between rivals, angled in along the rail late and retreated. WHOA SAILOR dueled from along the rail and was finished early.
