Footnotes

PAPA DO RIGHT advanced outside, angled in two wide on the bend, took over midstretch and shook off ITSHIM (GB) the final sixteenth. ITSHIM (GB) soon had a clear lead, had the rail on the turn but did not have enough left the final furlong. HARALDO (CHI) without early foot, picked up his pace on the turn, came four wide into the lane, steadily closed the gap and caught VINNY V. for third late. VINNY V. raced in contention between horses from the beginning, three wide taking the bend, had every chance but finished evenly. TIZTIME crowded after the break, moved inside early, swung out leaving the turn and gradually made up ground through the lane. PRINCE CARSON was prominent early, steadied while along the rail on the turn and flattened out for the drive. DOS AND DON'TS was an early factor between rivals but faded from outside on the turn. ABSOLUTELY TRUE did not show early speed, backed up from inside on the bend, floated out some into the stretch and had little left.
