**Footnotes**

CHEROKEE CHEYENNE prominent from the beginning, advanced four wide on the turn, gradually angled out to stay clear of IZE ON MOLLY BOO midstretch and moved clear inside the final sixteenth. SHAE N DENAE well placed inside, bid for the lead in the stretch, could not hold back CHEROKEE CHEYENNE in the late going but won her battle for the place. BAB AT THE BOWSTER (IRE) chased from between horses, progressed three wide through the turn, had a striking position midstretch but could only get third nearing the wire. IZE ON MOLLY BOO soon had the lead, was just off the rail on the turn, floated out some entering the stretch, was challenged from both sides and gradually drifted out the last furlong. INITIAL T was soon well back, in paths three then four through the bend and passed between tired rivals in the stretch. SAID I WOULDNT in contention between horses, began to yield two wide on the turn. LITTLE MANDATE an early factor, failed to keep up four wide on the turn, swung out further for the drive and had no late bid. DESPERATE MEASURES void of speed, was just of the rail on the bend, floated out some into the lane and lacked a significant response. APRIL SPOOLS a factor between rivals on the backstretch, gained the inside on the turn and gave way. BAIL OUT MOM in the second flight between horses, began to tire three wide leaving the turn, fanned to path five for the stretch run and continued to fade.
