PLATINUM PRO boxed in just off the rail on the backstretch, split rivals two wide with a quarter mile left, rallied inside his rivals in the lane, gained the advantage nearing the final sixteenth and edged ahead under steady handling. GO BLAKERS GO in contention between horses, moved to the outside midway on the backstretch, lost ground as he commenced his bid five wide on the second turn, lugged in some deep stretch, came up short but caught JACKS LAST CHANCE for second. JACKS LAST CHANCE moved up quickly in close quarters between horses to share the lead on the first turn, moved clear and stayed just off the rail on the second bend, floated out some entering the stretch, was challenged from inside, tried hard but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. SQUAD LEADER pressed from outside on the backstretch, failed to keep up four wide on the second bend, fanned out further for the stretch run, lacked a rally but was clearly best of the rest. SPIRIT MASTER a step slow at the break, was soon well back, had the rail on the second turn, floated out to path five into the lane and passed a couple rivals. OLD CHARTER WHO reluctant to load, broke alertly from the gate, shared the lead from inside, could not stay with JACKS LAST CHANCE through the second bend and flattened out for the drive. KINDA SHINY advanced outside to share the lead on the backstretch but began to tire three wide leaving the second turn.
