Footnotes

KOOL K. O. was void of early speed, gained steadily into the turn, then swung out eight wide in the stretch to close with urging and was up in the final strides. SILKY KING was within striking distance early racing five wide, rallied in the stretch, placed a game try but was outfinished by closing foe. SILENT PURPOSE forced the early pace, sustained a bid to duel briefly in the stretch then yielded. NIGHT VICTOR was unhurried early racing off the rail, angled three wide at the top of the stretch then altered inward at the eighth pole then flattened. SWITHIN pressed the early pace from between foes, gained a short lead then dueled briefly in the stretch and weakened late. MINERS SHINER was outrun early racing three wide, angled in to save some ground and placed a mild bid. STORM OVER PAWNEE showed early speed racing four wide, angled in through the turn then gave way. SIBERIAN NATIVE broke slow, saved ground early and was not a factor. HALF PIPE raced mid pack five wide then faded.
