INDIAN EXPRESS moved up quickly inside, set a pressured pace then edged clear of JO DEE WHO late under a drive. JO DEE WHO bumped hard with I M AKING at the start, vied for the early lead from outside, came four wide out of the lane and wore down the final sixteenth. DISTINGUISH in tight between rivals at the start, advanced six wide on the bend, closed well while dueling for third and got it late. SHARM progressed from inside through the turn, was angled five wide for the stretch run, lodged a mild bid and was narrowly outfinished for the show. GO KITTY GO in contention early from outside, lost considerable ground seven wide on the bend and weakened in the lane. I M AKING bumped hard at the start, was steadied, was also six wide through the turn and passed tired ones through the stretch. LORENZON vied for the early lead between rivals, was angled out five wide leaving the turn and faded. DOWN PLAY soon trailed and showed little in a ground-saving trip. MR. GLENDALE raced close up in the second flight between rivals but faltered on the turn, was eased through the stretch and walked off. GREAT SAMSON pressed the early speed just outside MR. GLENDALE, gave way into the turn, drifted out, was pulled up in the stretch and also walked off.
