Footnotes

AWESOME LAUNCH settled off the inside, picked up his pace going to the second turn, advanced widest on that bend, came to CODIO nearing the eighth pole, dug in under steady urging and edged ahead in the waning yards. CODIO advanced from outside, five wide into the second turn, angled in some to be three wide as he took over leaving that turn, was clear as he lugged in at the top of the stretch, drifted out under a left whip with a furlong to go, fought gamely but had to settle for second best. LEMON CUSTARD was kept close toward the outside, came into the lane three wide, battled for third, failed to close the gap much on the top pair the last eighth but was clearly best of the rest. HONOURAMONGFRIENDS stalked from between horses, went for the lead four wide on the second turn, angled in some leaving that bend, began to back up and was altered in after entering the last furlong. BROTHER WARBUCKS broke in the air, advanced between horses, was steadied behind traffic shortly after entering the backstretch, progressed three or four wide to the second turn, started to fade, swung widest for the drive and only passed a few tired ones. OUR BIG SQUEEZE dueled for the lead just off the inside for six furlongs then flattened. JUBILAEM displayed early speed just outside OUR BIG SQUEEZE but gave way for the drive. YOUAREFUN was prominent along the rail for more than a half mile, came off the inside some entering the second turn and faded. STAR COURT pressed the pacesetters just off the inside, was blocked and looking for room on the backstretch, moved to the rail into the second bend then gave way.
