Footnotes

HIGH ROCKER sent up, gained the lead after a furlong, stayed just off the inside through the bend, was roused upper stretch and maintained control under steady handling. FRED'S HENNESSY kept close between horses, took over second three wide on the bend, tried hard in the lane but could only pull away from the rest. FULL OF PRIDE in contention outside from the beginning, lost ground four wide through the turn, battled for third in the stretch and narrowly prevailed. MILLER WHO settled inside, began to swing out on the turn, came into the stretch behind FULL OF PRIDE, altered outside that one nearing the eighth pole, closed well and just missed for third. FOR DEVON SAKE hard sent to contest the early pace, could not stay with HIGH ROCKER nearing the half mile pole, followed that one through the turn, fought to keep third in the stretch but did not have enough left nearing the wire. EGO AND HONOR loose behind the starting gate, was retrieved, broke well, bumped with CAHONE CREEK shortly after the start, saved ground taking the bend then tired for the drive. CAHONE CREEK caught in crowding shortly after the start, bumped with EGO AND HONOR, was steadied, moved to the inside with a half mile left and steadily gave way.
