Footnotes

QUIET AGAIN rated between horses early, was boxed in on the second turn, got through four wide leaving that bend, surged to the lead then continued to open up under a mild drive. HOPE FOR PEACE bumped with PERSHING at the start, shared the lead two or three wide from the early going, was no match for QUIET AGAIN in the stretch, battled for second between rivals and narrowly held on. GUIDING HAND prominent four wide, commenced his bid on the second bend, led briefly as he angled in some leaving that turn, fought for the place shortly after that but did not have enough left in the waning yards. CHIMES HAS A SONG soon trailed just off the inside, picked up his pace going to the second turn, swung out four wide for the drive and steadily improved his position. MR. PURSUIT also bumped with PERSHING at the start, contested the pace from inside for more than six furlongs then slowly wore down in the lane. IMPERIAL OFFICER well placed inside from the early going, altered out to path three at the top of the lane and lacked the needed response. PERSHING pinched back at the break, was angled out early, stayed wide the rest of the way and showed late interest. MAJESTIC STREAM contended three or four wide to the second turn then faded. FOLSUM pressed from outside but faded five wide on the second bend. REGAL CAREER was an early factor outside but gave way six wide after five furlongs.
