**Footnotes**

NINE MIRACLES just behind the pacesetter on the backstretch, was boxed in behind ORABELL on the turn, steadied behind traffic upper stretch, bumped with SMART CITY DOC a couple times as she squeezed through between rivals inside the final furlong and was drawing off the last seventy yards. ORABELL quickly overcame a bobble at the break to set the pace just off the inside, took the rail on the turn, moved clear and floated out a bit entering the stretch, regained the inside with a furlong to go, tried hard, did not have enough left in the waning yards and narrowly held second. RED ALARM came off the rail some midway on the backstretch, lost ground taking the bend four to six wide, rallied in the stretch and narrowly missed for the place. SMART CITY DOC pressed the early speed from outside, took the turn three wide, began to yield inside the furlong marker, was bumped slightly a couple times nearing the last sixteenth and finished evenly. WEDNESDAYAFTERNOON soon trailed from outside, lost ground taking the bend five to seven wide then steadily advanced in the lane without threatening. INITIAL T broke inward, chased from inside, came off the rail some upper stretch for a clear path but lacked a

rally. JOCHEBED in the second flight between horses, was just off the inside through the turn, failed to keep up entering the lane, was forced to alter four wide at the top of the stretch when she lost her path to NINE MIRACLES and gradually yielded between horses. SHOULD also in midpack on the backstretch, progressed to contention just off the inside on the bend, failed to keep up as she angled out to path four at the head of the lane and continued to fade. BEENCAUGHTCHEATING was away slowly, showed no speed, improved position two wide on the turn but lacked a stretch bid. FLYING HELMSMAN broke outward, was checked, lost ground on the turn, was widest entering the stretch and had little to offer. CHILLUM was an early factor but faded three wide on the bend. BADGETT'S ROYAL was also away slowly, moved up between horses to gain a striking position three wide on the turn, fanned out to path five entering the lane, tired and lugged in midstretch.
