WHISPERED STRIKE hesitated then made a leap from the gate, was settled, picked up his pace going to the turn, squeezed through traffic midway on the bend, swung four wide for the stretch run, was all out and got up in time. SMEDLEY drifted out a bit to bump with SAILOR'S HALO shortly after the break, dueled for the lead outside CAPE SABLE, was two wide through the bend, shook free under a drive inside the sixteenth marker, was still clear with seventy yards left but outfinished in a game effort. CAPE SABLE gradually angled in as he disputed the pace, had the rail taking the turn, tried hard but did not have enough left the final sixteenth. H. C. MYSTERY chased the top pair from paths two or three and lacked a significant stretch response. CHARLIE'S SONG ran in the second flight briefly from inside, could not keep up along the rail through the bend and had no late bid. SAILOR'S HALO broke alertly, was bumped shortly after the break, chased briefly from outside but gradually gave way once into the turn.
