**Footnotes**

STRONG PUNCH bumped at the start, was settled, closed the gap three wide on the turn, swung out to path five for the stretch run, altered out from behind SAINT VIC shortly after that, was forced out wider to avoid SAINT VIC nearing the eighth pole, rallied under a drive, gained the lead inside the final furlong and was gradually drawing off. FULL OF PRIDE without early foot, improved position three wide on the turn, fanned out some for the stretch run, was blocked briefly, altered in with a furlong left, split rivals inside the last eighth and moved clear for second nearing the wire. TIO TIO came off the rail midway on the backstretch, was two and three wide taking the turn, altered in for a clear path upper stretch, vied for the lead shortly after entering the final furlong but hung in the late going. SAINT VIC forwardly placed between horses, waited for room behind the leaders while three wide on the turn, got through five wide at the head of the lane, drifted out under left-handed pressure nearing the eighth pole, was corrected but did not have enough left. CAKE AND CANDY contested the pace between rivals, was three wide through the bend, also drifted out some one straightened for the drive and gradually yielded inside the last eighth. BLUE JACKET SAILOR vied for the lead from outside, was four wide taking the turn, caught in tight quarters briefly just outside CAKE AND

CANDY upper stretch, also began to wear down and was crowded by the latter through the late going. FIRE BRIGADE in midpack on the backstretch, lost considerable ground taking the turn five to seven wide and was gradually altered in looking for a clear path through the lane. ABO HOTWIRE bumped with STRONG PUNCH at the start, was soon well back, had the rail into the turn, angled out leaving the bend, was five wide at the top of the lane, altered in some for a clear path, improved his position and altered in deep stretch trying to avoid FIRE BRIGADE. LEGSAROLLING broke inward, dueled for the lead between horses, could not keep up entering the stretch, soon gained the rail and continued to fade. SILVER NITE R F displayed early speed from inside, also began to tire leaving the turn, came off the rail some for a clear path entering the stretch and steadily gave way. I TELL THE TALE was a step slow at the break then altered in quickly to stay clear of LEGSAROLLING, stayed off the inside and showed little. RULEOUT pressed from outside, followed BLUE JACKET SAILOR on the turn, began to fade leaving the bend, floated out to the middle of the track into the stretch and steadily gave way.
