Footnotes

PROJECTION kept close just off the inside, went for the lead two wide on the bend, moved clear upper stretch, was all out and held off NUGGET QUEEN. The latter contested the pace between horses, was four wide taking the bend, could not stay with PROJECTION upper stretch, closed the gap some inside the final furlong, leveled off in the late going but was clearly second best. A J'S FLICKA pressed from outside, lost ground five wide through the turn, lacked the extra needed for the drive but caught EMMASVALENTINEGIRL for third. EMMASVALENTINEGIRL vied for the lead between horses, was three wide on the turn and gradually wore down for the drive. SHE'S WAY COOL crowded at the start, trailed from outside, lost considerable ground taking the bend, came into the lane from the middle of the track, closed well but too late. IRISH SKIRT in contention between rivals, was three wide on the turn, did not keep up fanning to path six entering the stretch but was making up ground the last eighth. FLIRTY FALETA without speed from between horses, lost ground four

wide on the turn, swung out to path seven for the drive, angled in some upper stretch and improved position. BREA stumbled at the break, quickly recovered to be an early factor, advanced just off the inside on the bend but flattened out through the lane. PRINCESS MCKENZY broke outward, showed no speed from between horses, was just off the inside on the turn, fanned out some for the stretch run and lacked a significant response. GOLDIEWHIZ broke on top but outward, was an early factor from outside but faded five wide leaving the bend. RETREAT HOME an early factor from inside, began to tire leaving the turn, swung out between horses into the lane and continued to give way. OPENCONTAINER gradually retreated from between horses, moved to the rail on the bend and had no late bid.
