Footnotes

OUR FLYING ANGEL stalked from outside, advanced from path four then five taking the bend, lugged in midstretch, was corrected and gradually edged ahead of AMBERS PRIDE in the waning yards. AMBERS PRIDE sent to contest the pace between rivals, in paths three and four through the turn, gained a narrow advantage upper stretch, forced in some with a furlong to go, did not relent but did not have enough left late. SHAMROCK GIRL drifted out some as she vied for the early lead off the rail but inside her rivals, was just off the rail taking the turn and gradually wore down the final eighth. MARTINI TO GO taken to the inside early on, had the rail on the turn, fanned out to path three for the stretch run, angled out further for a clear path inside the last furlong but finished evenly. YOUR WILD EMINENCE also moved toward the inside early on, just off the rail on the bend, swung out to path six for the drive and had no late bid. GOING WEST GAL was soon well back and failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. ANGEL PEAK displayed brief speed between horses but gave way from path three on the turn, was unresponsive in the stretch and in hand through the waning yards.
