**Footnotes**

SANDIA'S FLICKA broke alertly, set a pressured pace between horses, gained the inside on the turn, drew clear just off the rail in the stretch and held on under steady handling. RED LIFESAVER was well placed inside from the beginning, was altered out three wide when her path narrowed near the sixteenth pole, closed the gap some and held onto the place. CULPEPER MOON kept close throughout, was boxed in two to three wide through the bend, gained a clear path in the upper stretch then found best stride too late. CHAMP'S ROCKET far back early, commenced her bid along the rail on the turn, then steadily progressed inside through the lane. SABRINA SLEW pressed the pace between horses, three to four wide on the bend then slowly wore down in the stretch. CORONADO ROSE dueled for the early lead from outside, two wide leaving the turn then flattened out for the drive. SHEMOVESLIKEAGHOST raced in the second flight from outside, five wide into the stretch then also wore down. DEE DEE'S DINER was an early contender running widest of all but weakened in the lane. STRAWBERRY PET a factor between foes through the early going, came four wide into the stretch and had no late bid.
