UNIQUE CRUISE pressed the early pace from the inside, gained the advantage into the turn, edged clear briefly, drifted out nearing the wire and held sway. AMYBELLE set a pressured early pace, was challenged into the turn, yielded into the stretch, then battled back in the late going but didn't have enough late. KISSA SUNFLOWER was off slow early, closed the gap nearing the quarter pole, was fanned five wide into the stretch and finished well to get up for the show. WEDNESDAYAFTERNOON prompted the early pace three wide, lacked a gain and went evenly late. LITTLE MISS RULER was within striking distance early racing off the rail, sustained a brief bid then weakened. NO TEARS broke slowly, then angled in to save ground, settled into stride down the backstretch and lacked a rally. ENJOY TO THE WORLD was forwardly placed early five wide and lacked a late effort. POSSIBLE showed little in a dull effort. SAMBRE dropped back early trailing the field and was not a factor.
