Footnotes

DESERT FLAG stalked in hand from inside on the first turn, moved up three wide between horses to share the lead on the backstretch, began to draw off when let out on the second turn, was just off the inside entering the lane, lengthened command under a drive and was kept to task to the wire. TABERS BIG GIRL settled, gradually progressed just off the inside on the backstretch, had the rail into the second turn, swung out to path three leaving that bend, was all out in the stretch, took over second inside the last furlong then slowly closed the gap on the leader as she pulled away for the place. EL OF RUCKUS prominent four wide early, failed to keep up while just off the inside on the second bend, fanned outside TABERS BIG GIRL for the stretch run, lacked a significant bid but moved clear for third late. WEST OF ROME chased from outside, four to six wide taking the second turn and lacked a rally in the lane. I'M A WINDTALKER unruly in the gate, broke somewhat slowly and outward, bumped DISAPPEARING LADY, trailed just off the inside, swung out four wide entering the lane, began to pass between tiring rivals, gradually forced in deep stretch and bumped in the waning yards. OPENCONTAINER vied for the early lead from outside, was three wide between rivals on the backstretch, had a brief lead two wide early in the second turn, could not stay with DESERT FLAG midway on that bend, took the rail into the stretch and began to wear down. ONEEYEGOST was soon well back from outside, gradually angled in on the backstretch, three wide into the second turn, fanned out to path six for the stretch run, slowly lugged in after entering the last furlong and bumped I'M A WINDTALKER. TOMMY JO vied for the early lead between horses, took the rail leaving the first turn, began to tire after five furlongs, floated out some into the stretch and steadily gave way. DISAPPEARING LADY bumped from the rear just after the start, failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. PRIDE OF GOLD was prominent from outside but gave way three wide on the second turn.
