Footnotes

OKLAHOMA MULE kept close between horses, lost position while four wide taking the turn, floated out to path six entering the stretch, lugged in some inside the last furlong, had a slight lead with a sixteenth left then edged further ahead under steady handling. NOCO bumped with SOLAR BLAST at the start, was settled from outside, picked up his pace as he angled in entering the turn, advanced just off the inside, found himself behind GOOD THING GOING leaving the bend, altered to the rail at the top of the lane, out to path three near the eighth pole, closed well willingly between horses and caught GOOD THING GOING nearing the wire. GOOD THING GOING shared the early lead between rivals, moved ahead and stayed just off the inside on the turn, was all out through the lane, did not have enough left but was easily best of the rest. D T ROCKET away slowly, was void of speed from inside, gradually swung out on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and steadily advanced without threatening. SCATTER DOODLE also bumped solidly with SOLAR BLAST at the break, raced in the second flight between horses, was three wide through the turn, altered out some when NOCO came close midstretch, altered outside OKLAHOMA MULE approaching the final sixteenth then continued to gradually drift outward. COMMANDANT JONES soon made his way inside, saved ground the rest of the way and had no late bid. SWAPIANO came off the inside midway on the backstretch, advanced two wide on the bend, fanned out further for room entering the stretch but lacked a rally. SOLAR BLAST was squeezed between horses at the break and checked, soon trailed from outside, was widest taking the turn and only passed tired ones through the lane. FOOLIN WHO contested the pace from inside on the backstretch, could not stay with GOOD THING GOING on the turn, floated out some into the stretch and steadily gave way. AIN'TNOSLOWRIDE displayed early speed from outside but faded four wide through the bend. SWISSWRISTWATCH prominent between horses on the backstretch, quit just off the inside

through the turn, distanced himself in the lane and walked off.
