Footnotes

BRAX bumped with DODSON at the start, stalked from between horses, went for the lead four wide on the bend, took over upper stretch and gradually opened up under a drive. DODSON bumped with BRAX at the break, progressed toward the outside, was three to five wide taking the turn, loomed a threat midstretch, was no match for BRAX in the late going but lasted for the place. H. E.'S FAST in contention early, had the rail on the turn, angled out six wide for a clear path at the top of the lane and gained third in the waning yards. SILVER MATTHAIS prominent between horses, lost ground widest through the bend and improved his position some belatedly. AMOROSO contested the pace between horses, was three wide taking the turn and gradually wore down for the drive. EL GRAN COGNAC broke outward, vied for the lead off the rail but inside his rivals, could not keep up just off the inside on the bend and gradually yielded the last furlong. UPTOWN EGO an early factor from outside, faded five wide on the turn. JOHN PEARL steadied behind traffic at the start, trailed, gradually swung out through the turn, came into the stretch from the middle of the track and lacked a significant response.
