TAKEDOWN was rated off the early speed and taken inside, moved up between horses on the bend, rallied from path four in the lane then drew clear under a drive in the late going. MOUNTAIN DREAMER stalked the pacesetters, went for the lead three wide on the turn, had the lead in the lane but was no match for the winner the last sixteenth. SENECA STAGE was away slowly, stayed wide throughout then passed tired ones from outside to get third near the wire. WAGERMONEY HONEY settled inside, advanced along the rail on the turn, swung out to path three for the stretch run but had no rally. PRINCE CARSON was kept close, boxed in nearing the turn, angled four wide into the lane but lacked a late bid. MOVIN' MUSIC dueled for the lead two wide for a half mile then flattened. READY STEADY GO was a brief factor from outside but faded four wide on the bend. AMAJAMMER battled for the lead inside but gave way leaving the turn.
