Footnotes

D' ELEGANCE rated on the front end from outside, was just off the rail on the bend, moved clear leaving the quarter pole, was under a drive inside the final furlong and held sway. KRISTEN BLITZEN hustled along from inside on the backstretch, swung out widest on the turn, was in path five entering the stretch, all out the last eighth, took over second nearing the final sixteenth and was getting to the winner late. LOOSEWHEELSLUCILLE dueled for the lead between rivals, gained the rail into the turn, could not stay with D' ELEGANCE leaving the bend, angled outside the latter midstretch and slowly yielded. SKIPPY without early foot, was inside entering the turn, swung out to path three for the stretch run and had to weave through traffic inside the final eighth. SIOUX QUEEN without speed between horses, angled in entering the bend, progressed to midstretch, leveled off after that but was easily best of the rest. RUFF N WITTY soon trailed from outside, took the turn from paths two and three and lacked a significant stretch response. SPORTINA displayed early speed off the rail but inside her rivals and gave way leaving the bend. SWISS JEWEL steadied at the break, showed no speed well off the inside, was in path four entering the turn, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch run and was empty.

KEENELAND Winner sold through Keeneland Association, Inc.
