JESSE JR brushed start, mild drive, drawing off. BLAME IT ON FAME broke inward, vied, no match late. TNL STEL pressed, not enough late. MARK THIS CASH crowded start, even effort. EASY DOWN CORONA lugged in near 1/16, bothered rivals-dq. FIRST MOVE TO CASH forced in near 1/16, in tight late. DCW HOME GROWN brushed start, no late bid. DASHING N DODGING forced in near 1/16, checked. GEDOG altered in early, squeezed 1/16, checked. HOUSTON SEGUNDA forced in early, squeezed 1/16, checked. There was a stewards' inquiry into the race. After their review, EASY DOWN CORONA was disqualified and placed tenth for coming in without being clear and initiating a chain reaction of interference.
