Footnotes

ON A BURNER vied for the lead inside from the beginning, was under steady urging in the stretch, bumped inside the final furlong but held gamely. R SKYDIVER contested the pace outside ON A BURNER, was all out in the lane, lugged in some to bump the latter deep stretch and had to settle for second best. THE HUNT IS ON checked behind traffic into the first turn, stayed in hand from inside early on, swung out four wide for the stretch run, steadily closed the gap, bumped with HIDDEN RECIPE near the wire and was too late. HIDDEN RECIPE settled the first half mile, commenced his bid between horses on the second turn, fanned five wide for the stretch run, rallied just outside THE HUNT IS ON in the lane and bumped with that one just before the wire. GAMBLER BILL advanced toward the outside, was three wide on the second bend, boxed in through the lane, altered out deep stretch but got through too late. MILLER'S TIME angled outside at the halfway point, went for the lead four wide on the second turn, angled in some entering the lane, lacked the extra needed and altered out to stay clear of GAMBLER BILL near the wire. BAIL OUT THE CAT five wide on the first turn, was caught in close quarters between rivals midway on the backstretch and faded just off the inside on the second bend. RACE FOR JAKE gradually backed up just off the inside, swung out widest for the drive and had little left.
