TANGO TYLER bumped from the rear after the start, waited behind the early speed, got through four wide leaving the bend, gradually angled in as he took over the lead upper stretch then continued to draw away under a drive. BULL FLYS showed the way from inside, moved clear leaving the turn, was no match for TANGO TYLER when set down for the drive but held off CHEROKEE ROLL for second under steady urging. CHEROKEE ROLL prominent from outside, improved position three wide on the turn, was forced in some as TANGO TYLER angled in upper stretch, angled back out three wide with a furlong left and narrowly held third. MISSION DELTA showed first, was soon in midpack from the outside, lost ground taking the bend five wide and was getting to CHEROKEE ROLL late. JEWELL'S KING trailed early, advanced along the rail on the turn, swung out five wide into the stretch and steadily advanced. DART GUN jostled with JON shortly after the break, ran in midpack between horses, was just off the inside taking the bend, failed to have a stretch bid and had to be vanned off. QUITE A LINE also jostled with JON after the start, showed no speed between rivals, four wide on the turn, lost further ground fanning to path seven into the stretch and closed the gap some the last eighth. EL PROSPECTO lost ground in a wide trip and passed tired ones through the

stretch. TRICK RYDER was forwardly placed inside on the backstretch, backed up along the rail on the turn, came off the inside some entering the lane and continued to fade. TRADERS TURN void of speed from outside, lost position widest on the turn and was gradually in through the stretch. JON roughed between horses after the break, bobbled and faded six wide on the turn. ANCIENT APPEAL displayed early speed between horses but quit just off the inside leaving the bend.
