Footnotes

CATCH THE BEAN unruly in the post parade and behind the gate, was settled outside early, gradually progressed on the backstretch, four then five wide taking the second bend, slowly lugged in while all out in the lane but got up in time. JADED DREAMS moved clear on the first turn, took the inside on the backstretch, floated out some leaving the second turn, fought gamely but did not have enough left. ELEGANT MOVES steadied briefly when his path narrowed leaving the first turn, stayed just behind JADED DREAMS on the backstretch, got through two wide nearing the quarter pole, fanned out further into the lane, duelled between rivals, also did not have enough late but proved easily best of the rest. MIKEY TOO forced to be six wide into the first turn, gradually angled in leaving that bend, pressed the pacesetter from just outside, floated out a bit midway on the second turn and began to tire. SUPER SAPELLO without early speed, gradually closed the gap from path three on the backstretch, came into contention along the rail on the second bend but could not sustain his bid through the lane. KY'S QUEST void of speed just off or along the rail, moved to the outside upper stretch and had no late bid. PACHE ECHO STAR was also steadied when his path was taken leaving the first turn, altered outside MIKEY TOO into the backstretch and gave way between horses early in the second bend.
