SMASH DANCER vied for the lead outside from the beginning, moved ahead three wide leaving the turn, was clear in the lane, gradually drifted out the last furlong but held on. OUR CHOICE bumped at the break, was gradually moved to the outside on the backstretch, four wide through the bend, all out in the stretch, gradually angled out to stay clear of SMASH DANCER in the late going, was too late but easily second best. COMIC SMARTY CAT disputed the pace from inside, could not stay with SMASH DANCER leaving the turn, was no match for OUR CHOICE inside the final furlong but narrowly held onto third under steady handling. REAL FLAXY in the second flight between horses, was three to five wide taking the bend, lugged in deep stretch and narrowly missed the show. Z Z DOME chased from not far off the inside, had the rail through the turn, failed to have a stretch bid and was altered outside COMIC SMARTY CAT nearing the wire. STONE COLD ROCK broke inward, bumping OUR CHOICE, quickly recovered to vie for the lead between horses, was two wide through the turn and tired for the drive.
