Footnotes

BIG DIVOT shared the lead from between horses, moved clear when asked into the lane then held sway under a mild drive. LIZ'S PIRATE forwardly placed inside, fanned out some entering the lane, took over second inside the eighth pole, angled outside BIG DIVOT with a sixteenth to go, lacked the needed bid but held off QUON'STRICK for second. QUON'STRICK raced in contention from outside, lost ground four to six wide taking the bend and found best stride too late the last eighth. TOUGH PILGRIM was prominent between horses early, swung out to path four entering the stretch, battled for second and began to wear down as he angled out to keep clear of LIZ'S PIRATE at the sixteenth marker. CHEROKEE STALKER was also a contender between rivals on the backstretch, swung out behind TOUGH PILGRIM entering the lane, lacked a rally and was altered out as the latter came out deep stretch. LAST GAMBLE bumped with MY HOUSE MY RULES at the start, advanced from inside on the turn, came off the rail some nearing the eighth pole to progress but ran evenly through the late going. WHERE'S THE DOUGH soon trailed from outside, was four to six wide taking the bend and improved his position through the stretch without threatening. BIG SKY DRAGON without speed between rivals, was four and five wide on the turn, angled inside to stay clear of GRUBBY WHO midstretch and had no late bid. GRUBBY WHO forwardly placed between horses, also came five wide into the stretch and began to tire. MY HOUSE MY RULES bumped with LAST GAMBLE at the start, dueled for the lead from inside but flattened out for the drive. DIGNIFIED DONOVAN showed no speed, stayed well off the inside and lacked a stretch bid. NOTIME TO BADINAGE was urged along from inside but showed little.
